Descriptions of Membership Types

- **Full Members** are eligible to submit to all of SCl's activities, including national and regional conferences, the SCI CD Series, the SCI Performer's CD Series, Composerver, and the SCI Journal of Music Scores. Full members receive the SCI Newsletter and SCION, and are eligible to vote on Society matters and in elections for the National Council. (\$75/year)
- **Joint Membership** is designed for parties who reside at the same physical address. Joint Members enjoy the same benefits as full members. Please provide both names in the NAME field above, and indicate separate e-mail addresses. (\$100/year)
- **Senior Membership** is open to retired composers or those at least 65 years of age. Senior Membership carries the same benefits as Full Membership. (\$35/year)
- **Proxy Membership** is open to the widow(er), longtime companion, friend, or estate of a deceased composer. Proxies are eligible to submit scores on behalf of the deceased composer for performance consideration at any conference for which the deceased would be eligible to submit scores if (s)he were alive and a member. The Proxy will receive the SCI Newsletter and SCION. (\$75/year)
- Associate Membership is available to performers and other interested professionals. Associates receive the SCI Newsletter and SCION, and may perform or give presentations at national and regional conferences, but may not submit scores for performance consideration. (\$40/year)
- **Student Membership** enables currently enrolled students to submit scores, papers, and panel presentations to all conferences. Students receive the SCI Newsletter and SCION. This membership type is for students who do not have access to a student chapter at their respective school. Please see the note on starting student chapters at the end of this form. (\$35/year)
- **Student Chapter Membership** provides the same benefits as student members, but is open only on campuses having a Student Chapter. (\$25/year)
- **Lifetime Membership** provides Full Member benefits for life. (\$1400 one-time payment or \$150/year for 10 years)

All members, with the exception of Institutional Members, are eligible to create personal profiles on the main SCI website, as well as add MP3 audio files and PDF versions of scores.

Starting a Student Chapter

If you are interested in forming a student chapter of SCI at your college or university please contact Dr. Nickitas Demos at Georgia State University (email: ndemos@gsu.edu). Student chapter members receive a \$10 discount on their annual dues, and if the chapter is a recognized club or student organization at its parent institution, the chapter is often eligible to receive university funds in support of its activities.
